



WHAT TO INCLUDE IN GROSS ORDINARY WAGES-COMMUNITY INDUSTRY LSL SCHEME

Include:

- Gross Ordinary wages
- Any above/over award payments
- Weekend work and public holiday penalty rates on normal rostered shifts forming ordinary hours of duty (other than overtime)
- ♣ Annual Leave (where taken as leave)
- Bereavement Leave
- ♣ Carer's Leave
- Casual Loading
- Long Service Leave (where taken as leave and paid by employer)

- Public Holidays
- Sick Leave
- Workers Compensation payments (when made by the employer in first instance and employer is then reimbursed by insurance company)
- Jury Service
- Maternity/Paternity Leave paid by employer
- ♣ First Aid Allowance
- Department of Education Allowance

Exclude:

- Overtime
- Leave Loading
- Leave without pay
- Lump sum payments for accrued annual leave, sick leave or long service leave paid on termination
- Payments in Lieu of notice
- Christmas Bonuses and ex-gratia payments
- Travel allowance

- ♣ Payments for materials & equipment
- One-off bonuses
- Meal allowance
- Protective clothing allowance
- Workers compensation payments where they are paid directly paid by the insurance company
- Redundancy payments
- Maternity/Paternity Leave paid by the government

Definition of ORDINARY REMUNERATION for all Industries:

Long Service Leave (Portable Schemes) Act 2009 - Dictionary

Ordinary remuneration, for a person, means the amount paid or payable to

The person for work, other than any amounts for -

- (a) overtime; or
- (b) expenses incurred by the person; or
- (c) the use of materials, equipment or a motor vehicle provided by the person.
